Dojo Rules and Regulations

Only equipment authorized by the head instructor should be used in dojo practice.

The use of drugs or alcohol while in class or on dojo premises, is strictly prohibited.

Any student or guest found to be using drugs or alcohol, or discovered to be under the influence, will be asked to leave the class for that day.

Theft is a criminal offence and will be dealt with harshly. Anyone discovered stealing on the premises will be apprehended and the proper authorities will be notified.

Assistant and replacement instructors (so designated and appointed by the head instructor) should be respected and their instructions followed.

In case of dispute over any instructions given, methods used or seemingly unjust treatment by any instructor during class, students should comply with such instructions for the duration of the class. Students should then discuss the matter privately with the head instructor after class has finished.

Instructions from the instructor should be followed to the best of one's ability. Blatant disobedience to reasonable demands and instructions from the instructor in charge will not be tolerated.

Foul, lewd, hostile, discriminatory and otherwise disturbing language, gestures and/or actions, which upset other members, guests and/or disrupt the class will not be tolerated and if not corrected immediately, will result in immediate dismissal from class.

The accumulation of three warnings, in verbal or written form, constitutes grounds for dismissal from the dojo and any and all subsequent classes, and for the termination of membership with the dojo.

The head instructor reserves the right to interpret, decide and arbitrate cases, where there is a dispute or when students continued membership with the dojo is in question, or to form a council which will have the power to decide such cases.

The above rules were created in the interests of the welfare of the members of the dojo and for the harmonious functioning of the dojo and its classes.

Infractions of the dojo rules will be dealt with promptly, justly and ultimately, in the interests of the members of the dojo.
